Check-in:

Upon arrival at the gate, you are expected to complete the necessary formalities with the Bursary and Student Affairs before receiving your hostel bed space allocation. Please check your platform for the fee schedule.

Hostel Accommodation:

You will be allocated a bed space, which won't be changed without approval from the Vice Chancellor or Registrar. Ensure you sign in with the porters before entry.

Induction Courses/Orientation Programme:

Participation is mandatory for both old and new students. Attendance will be recorded at every session. Kindly ensure to be present.

University Hospital:

The Arthur Jarvis University Hospital is well-equipped to cater to students' medical needs. Students who pay the medical fee will be registered on the Tertiary School Insurance Programme of the NHIA.

Dress Code:
